

Friday December 2. In the morning we
went off With orange-bay the boat was sent
on shore to be certain that it was orange-bay
the boat Return on board with som fruit and
said we was right so we beet up & came to
Anker. Just After Sun set Wind N E

Saturday: Fine Wether we Lay at Anker
In Orange-bay brok up the hole and started
9:30 Gallons of water and filled them with
Oyl and Stood the hole again and Scraped
the Clams off our bottom; in the morning
came a Conoe on board with a Negro man & boy
and brought a few orranges & Limes & one yam
the Capt. Give them som beef for them
In the Afternoon came two Negros from Prince
and Broat som Limes & oranges which the
Capt. Bought; This Day is my Birthday
I am 21 years old and No better yet; at night
filled 24 Casks of Salt water for Ballast

Sunday 4: filled 36 Casks of fresh
Water & finished Storing the Hole
My self; went on shore ^{in the morn} and Walked
about the Plantations all the fore noon
see if it would make me feel better.
Bought som oranges & Lemons of the
Negro & came on board about noon. Somethin
Remarkable this Day; Sam^l Atkins

Monday 5th fine Wether
Anker In orange bay; at 6 o'clock in
morning. Came a Conoe with two Negros
& Brought 900 oranges Which we bought
them for five bits p^r 100; at 10 o'clock the
Capt and mate went on shore & Bought som
Limes & Oranges; & Came on board at 12 o'clock
In the Afternoon the mate went on shore for
to sell som oyl but could not sell any
in the Afternoon came a Conoe from Prince
With two French men in it, and brought
som Oranges Which We Bought of them

Tuesday 6th Fine Wether but small
Winds. At 4 o'clock in the morn have up for to
to Prince-hoopus-bay & got to anker at 3 After
un bent fore top sail and Carried it ashore and mended
it and got a boat Load of Wood; there was a man
in Prince hoopus-bay the Change. Came on board of us
made no stop on board: the Ships name is the Charles
of 50 Guns

Wednesday 7th Good Wether
Anker in Prince-hoopus-bay; un bent main
sail. Carried it ashore and mended it; there came
a Sloop that Belonged to Dartmouth. Old
Commander is Days from home and Ankered by us
Went on shore & fetched the Capt & Mate
on board and they Went to Dinner
with us; Samuel Atkins
