this Day We are all well on board the Galley

Tuesday 20th Fresh Winds at W S W
the first part of the day at 1 o'clock
fresh at W B N. With some Rain (I put the
main top sail) handed it and the jib and
main top on the stay sail & kept the fore top
at 2 o'clock hove out the Reef out of the fore top
and set the jib Lat 30: 29

Wednesday 21st Winds at N N E Fresh
Wind with Rugged Sea Run N N W
At 11 o'clock unbent main top sail & sent down
the jack yard and main top sail yard and unhooked the Rig
At night Small Winds and Variable

Set up main Stay and Spring Stay at 12 o'clock
had the Wind N N E Run N B W
Lat 31: 21 Killed a large Shark
At night Very Squally with Rain

Friday 23rd Fine Weather the Wind
N N W Small Breeze Run N N W Lat 33: 7
See a Sail to the Leeward Last Night at 12 o'clock
We was a Breeze with Breeze

Saturday 24th Fine Weather and Small winds
N N W At 11 o'clock Calm Set up fore Shroud and
bent main sail at 12 o'clock had a fine Breeze at S W
Run N N W Lat 34: 18 Samuel Atkins

Sunday 25th Fine Weather the Wind Calm
the first part of the Day at 10 o'clock Calm
At 3 o'clock had a Breeze at S W B Lat 35: 30
at 4 o'clock changed the Current at night had many
Squally all night Wind from S S W to N N W

Monday 26th hard Wind at N N E See a
Sail about 2 miles to the Leeward under kept top sails
We have two under main stay sail & fore sail & fore
stay sail put in the Dead Lutes Saw a large Ship
headed to the S W at 10 o'clock blew a Gale of wind
the Wind from North to N W

Small Wind and a large Swell Run N N E
At 6 o'clock Afternoon Wind at E N E Run N N E
At 12 o'clock at night blew a Gale of wind from the
Wind E S E With a very Bad Sea
