Year 1774 John Barnard, Master of the  
Good Brig Polley

July 22<sup>nd</sup> Killed 22<sup>nd</sup> Sparmeetia (in Lat 19.30.2 North)  
Which made 36 Barrels

July 24<sup>th</sup> Killed one Sparmeetia that made 2 Barrels

July 29<sup>th</sup> Killed 2 Sparmeetia (in Lat 18.50.2 North)  
Which made 38 Barrels

August 2<sup>nd</sup> Killed one Sparmeetia (in Lat 18.52.0 North)  
Which made 22 Barrels

September 2<sup>nd</sup> Killed one Spalmecity (in Lat 18.52.0 North)  
Which made 210 Barrels

Sept 29<sup>th</sup> Killed one Spalmecity Which  
Made 16 Barrels

October 2<sup>nd</sup> Killed one Whail (in Lat 17.12.0 North)  
Which made 18 Barrels

October 11<sup>th</sup> Killed 2 Whails (in Lat 16.48.0 North)  
Which made 31 Barrels

Oct 18<sup>th</sup> Killed one Whail (in Lat 16.48.0 North)  
Which made 15 Barrels

In July We Got 5 Whales Which made 84 Barrels

In August We got 3 Whales Which made 22 Barrels

In September we got 2 Whales Which made 26 Barrels

In October we got 4 Whales Which made 64 Barrels

12 Whales 186 Barrels
