with light winds from the S a steering
E by S middle and latter part fine
saw a schooner bound to the W

Monday 14 These 24 hours commences
with moderate winds from the S a
steering E by S middle part and latter
part strong winds employed in various
jobs so ends

Lat 39.20 Long 33.17

Tuesday 15 These 24 hours commences
with strong winds a steering E by S
saw a steamer a steering to the W at
day light saw the island of Floris

Wednesday 16 These 24 hours fine
light winds from the W a steering
E by S first part passed the island
of Floris a steering for Sereera
middle part winds light at
day light saw Byall dist 20 miles

Thursday 17 These 24 hours
winds light from the W a steering
for Sereera at sun down dist 20 miles
a steering E by S middle part calms
latter part winds light from the W
so ends this day

Friday 18 These 24 hours light
winds at 4 am arrived of the bay
and the coast custom house officer
came of it being to late to do any business
stood off at 7 stood in shore and hallooed
a back the four yard and the capt started
from the ship put the wheel up to rear ship
but the wind being light she did not pay
off and there being a strong in set she
struck on a rock furlled the sails and
with assistance from the shore took the cog
about a stern and hove her of the ship is as
tight as ever knocked of some of our fids head
stood off and on the capt went on shore
to procure recruits so ends this day

Saturday 19 This day fine a lying off and
on the capt on shore a boat came of and brought some
liquor unbeknown to the officers and got drunk
and threatened to kill the officers one games with
struck the second mate and knocked him down the
four hob the capt came on board put them
in the rigging and capt then four hours took them
down and put them in irons
