Monday²³ There 24 hours commences with strong winds from the S a retching to the S.E. middle part moderate at day light made sail winds light from the W^h employed in trimming ship so ends

Tuesday²⁴ There 24 hours commences with light winds from the N^o a steering S.W. carried all sail middle part fine latter part employed in washing ship so ends and got 30 fathom

Lat 35.30 53.10

Wednesday²⁵ There 24 hours commences with light winds from the N^o a steering S. landed dust 50 miles saw two bryans bound in the river middle part the same at day light set sail and steered S at 8 p.m. saw two right whales lowered all four boats and the larboard boat ~~at~~ started but did not foon came on board some foggy saw a few hump backs so ends
