

Tuesday¹⁰ These 24 hours commenced with moderate winds from the N^W a steering W¹ S¹ W¹ saw several hump backs at sun down took in sail hauled to the S¹ W¹ at day light set sail saw a barque of four lee a boyling and with her boats down run of to her saw the whals and lowered our boats and chased a spell whals a going quick latter part saw more lowered but with eight seven whals a going quick so ends

Wednesday¹¹ These 24 hours commenced with light winds from the N^W a heading to the S saw two right whals but did not lower a going quick at sun down took in sail at day light set sail latter part saw the barque Old Yellow and back from N^W rook a boyling at sun down took in sail

Lat 38²² Long 55⁵¹
Thursday¹² These 24 hours commenced with light winds from the N^W a steering to the S¹ W¹ at 11 am spoke the bark Daniel wood of N^W Bedford middle part fine latter part spoke the Champion of Bayarton so ends

Friday¹³ These 24 hours commenced with light winds from the N^W a steering to the S middle part fine middle part fine saw three sails at sun down took in sail

Lat 39³⁵ Long 56³⁸
Saturday¹⁴ These 24 hours commenced with light winds from the N^W a steering S¹ W¹ at sun down hauled to and took in sail middle and latter part foggy

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Sunday¹⁵ These 24 hours commenced with light winds from the N^W some fog steering of S¹ W¹ saw a bark at sun down took in sail and hauled to the S at day light steered of W¹ S¹ W¹ all sail set latter part fine so ends

Lat 40¹⁰ Long
Monday¹⁶ These 24 hours commenced with light winds from the S a steering W¹ S¹ W¹ at sun down shortened sail and steered S by W¹ at day light set more sail latter part foggy with rain No Observation

Tuesday¹⁷ These 24 hours commenced with moderate winds from the N^W a steering S S¹ W¹ thick and foggy at day light more clear set sail and steered S so ends

Lat 42⁵⁰ Long 60⁴²
Wednesday¹⁸ These 24 hours commenced with strong winds from the N^W hauled up W¹ S¹ W¹ wether thick at 6 took in sail and hauled sharp by to the N^W latter part winds hauled to the S and breasted on took in all sail a blowing strong from the S with rain

Thursday¹⁹ These 24 hours commenced with a strong gale from the S a heading to the S took up the 2 boats middle part more moderate set some sail latter part the same

Friday²⁰ These 24 hours commenced with fine wether set all sail at sun down took in sail saw a sail to the W¹ at day light all in latter part the same
