with calms at 3 am winds light from the
N^W at sun down took in sail and layed
a back at day light steered of S S W and set
all sail winds light at 11 pm strong flares
took in light sail and hauled the main sail

Monday²⁰ These 24 hours commences
with light baffling winds some rain
at sun down took in sail and hauled
sharp by to the E strong winds and rain
at day light set sail and steered of S W
winds from the N^W no ends

Lat 44.47 64 37

These 24 hours commences with strong winds
and from the N^W & heading in for the land
at 2 am saw the land dist 20 miles at
sun down winds more to the W strong
flares of shore middle part a blowing heavy
latter part more moderate set some sail

Lat 44.59 S

Wednesday²² These 24 hours commences
with strong winds from the N^W & heading
to the west set all sail at 6 am calms
near the land of St Georges Bay
middle and latter part strong winds
a heading in for the land no ends

Lat 45.10 S

Thursday²³ These 24 hours commences
with strong winds at 1 am saw a right whale
lowered all four boats and the larboard boat
struck at 4 am took him a long side
employed in getting ready to cut middle
part strong winds at day light commenced to cut
latter part the same no ends

Friday²⁴ These 24 hours commences with the
winds more moderate employed in cutting
at 3 am finished cutting and stood in
for St Georges Bay land dist 25 miles
middle part moderate latter part strong
winds from the N^W & heading in shore

Lat 45.45 S 65.17

Saturday²⁵ These 24 hours commences
with the winds more moderate from the
S W & heading to the N^W employed in
cutting up blubber middle part and
from the S steered in for the land
at 9 pm stood of to the S E no ends

Lat 45.19 S 65.50

Sunday²⁶ These 24 hours commences
with light winds from the S at 1 am
winds hauled to the N^W & steered of middle
part strong winds at 6 pm steered of S
latter part winds from the N^W land
in sight

Lat 46.45 S 66.12

Monday²⁷ These 24 hours commences
with strong winds from the N^W &
steering down a long the land to the S
at sun down took in sail at day light
commenced to boil on our whale
strong winds as steering down a long the land

Lat 47.04 S 65.47
