Wednesday²⁹ These 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the N a steering S at 6 am ~~we~~ saw several right whales loared four boats and the Harbour boat struck and got stove the Haist boat took the line the whale run back at 8 cut from him came on board shortened sail employed in boylng middle and latter part fine

Thursday³⁰ These 24 hours commences with light winds from the N employed in boylng at 8 am speck the champion at 11 am finished cat boylng at day light set sail and stood to the S latter part more moderate the champion in sight

Sunday³ Dec 1865 These 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the E a steering S S W employed in shrooping bone middle part winds halled to the N steered S by the latter part saw the land so ends

Monday⁴ These 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the N a steering S W land in sight dist 15 miles middle part calms latter part winds light from the E with rain so ends

Tuesday⁵ These 24 hours commences with light boylng winds land in sight dist 25 miles middle part calms latter part light winds from the N a steering S

Wednesday⁶ These 24 hours commences with light boylng winds at 2 am strong winds from the S W with specks middle part calms latter part winds from the N W a steering in for the land of Gallegos river so ends

Thursday⁷ These 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the N a steering for Cape Virgin at 5 am finally took in light sail at 6 am a blowing heavy from the W took in all sail a heading to the S middle part the same latter part more moderate set sail and steered S E for Cape ~~Virgin~~ latter part moderate so ends this day
