Wednesday²⁸ There 24 hours commences
with strong trades a steady W. N. W.
land in sight middle part moderate

Thursday²⁹ There 24 hours commences
with strong trades a steady down a
long the land middle part moderate
latter part the same a steering down
long the land to Oahu so ends

Friday³⁰ There 24 hours commences
with light trades at 2 pm saw Oahu
employed in getting the anchors of the boat
middle part winds light a lying of anchor
at day light steered of for the passage
at 8 took a pilot at 9 the steamer hooked
on to us and towed us in at anchor

Saturday³¹ There 24 hours commences
with fine weather at sun down all hands
went on liberty one man on board for water
and one officer latter part hauled in
to the wharf and tied her up
and on bent the sails and
sent down the royal yards and
top & gannet yards so ends

Sunday¹ There 24 hours commences
with fine weather all hands on shore
middle and latter part fine

Monday² There 24 hours fine employed
in breaking out the P. Mary hole
middle and latter part fine

Tuesday³ All hands employed
in breaking out provisions and
storing it in the government store house
so ends this day all is well

Wednesday⁴ There 24 hours fine
employed in breaking out our oil
and putting it on the wharf middle
part fine winds from the S all well

Thursday⁵ There 24 hours cloudy some
rain winds from the S all hands employed
in breaking out the ground tier and
putting it on the wharf so ends

Friday⁶ There 24 hours some rain
and heavy squalls from the S ship heeled
over right up sheers and righted her
employed in hoisting eight sheers

Saturday⁷ There 24 hours fine
employed in hoisting eight pig iron balast
at 12 finished and washed the decks the
Barfinders employed in getting up three
Charnes to bear down on morning
turned our men of and payed them
of first officer 3 dollars per day second officer 2.50
third officer 2 dollars boatstewards 1.50 the men 1 dollar
latter part fine

Sunday⁸ There 24 hours commences
with fine weather all hands on liberty
middle and latter part fine
