all hands on shore except the cooper and
six men at work on the warf & setting up
shocks middle and latter part fine

Thursday 15 this day fine the Whistler arrived
with the mail from the states one whaler
arrived from the coast with ~~six~~ hundred this season
latter part ~~is~~ replaced the ship and winched her
round

Friday 16 There 24 hours fine the carpenters
a getting ready to leave the ship down on the other
side the bark Berings arrived with this mail
no arrivals of whalers no ends four men deserted

Saturday 17 this day fine finished the
ship bottom and righted her two whalers
arrived from the coast no ends

Sunday 18 There 24 hours commences
with fine wether the sterner arrived with
a mail no ends this day

Monday 19 There 24 hours commences
with fine wether all hands employed
in stowing in our pig iron no ends

Tuesday 20 There 24 hours commences with
fine wether employed in stowing the ground
ter and getting aboard some of our small
stores no ends

Wednesday 21 There 24 hours commences with
fine wether employed in stowing bread and
flour two ships arrived no ends

Thursday 22 There 24 hours commences
with fine wether employed in stowing
bread and meat no ends

Friday 23 There 24 hours commences
with fine wether employed in stowing
shock heads and shocks no ends

Saturday 24 There 24 hours commences with
fine wether employed in stowing sail, cash
and rigging no ends

Sunday 25 There 24 hours commences
with fine wether ~~no~~ all hands on shore

Monday 26 There 24 hours commences
with fine wether employed in putting
our boats over head and getting our anchors
up of the warf and getting ready to haul
of from the warf.

Tuesday 27 This day fine hauled the ship
of from the warf employed in getting
ready for sea no ends

Wednesday 28 There 24 hours commences
with fine wether employed in getting the ship
ready for sea three men deserted
