Friday¹⁵ These 24 hours commences with light winds from the W. of and on the ice middle part calms latter part spoke the ship *Deline* nothing this season so ends

Monday¹⁸ These 24 hours commences with strong winds from the N.W. first part saw whals hauled and the larboard boat struck middle part employed in cutting let go the anchor in 12 fathoms of water ten miles from the land while cutting the piece tore ought and the whale sunk took our anchor and made rail and got the whale up latter part hauled a gain and the larboard boat struck took him a long side so ends
