middle and latter part the same
saw several ships one & byling
Lat 40.1 S 170.00

to the S^W middle part spook the
St George latter part more moderate
and a snowing so ends

Lat 39.50 S 162.70
Saturday^s 15 there 24 hours
commences with strong winds
from the E and thick and snow
middle part spook the Nautilus

Sunday^s 16 there 24 hours
commences with moderate winds
from the N^W & strong & middle
part saw whales loosed all four
boats but with ought success saw
the Nautilus take two whales
so ends
