Sunday March 18 hours commences with light winds took in the bow boat middle and latter part fine

Monday 18th hours commences with light winds & steering N^W by N turned up the starboard and larboard boat and painted them latter part fine light winds

Lat 25.10 Long
Tuesday 19th hours commences with light winds & steering N^W first part tied a man in the rigging for hoarding a hole in the & cask of rum that stood on deck he was one that we had suspicion of setting fire to the ship in help the capt capt him tied up by the thumbs until he acknowledged that he and one of the boatsteers set fire to the ship with the intention of burning her up they day previous this boatsteer jumped over board in the night and swam on shore with the intention of running a way in the morning the capt was informed of one of the boatsteers leaving the ship in the night while a blowing stormy on shore with both anchors & head and he in charge of the deck they was fifty dollars reward offered for him and was caught and sent on board and put in irons that night he got his irons off by the help of one and set the ship on fire but was discovered in time to put it out. Friday 22nd hours commences with light winds from the N & steering sharp by to the N^W employed in mending the spanker middle and latter part winds light - so ends

Saturday 23rd hours commences with light winds from the S & steering N^W by N employed in bending the four staysail and main top mast staysail and inner staysail so ends

Sunday 24th hours commences with light winds from the S & steering N^W by N middle part the same latter part rainy with squalls took in four top gunnissail and gaff topsail so ends

Lat 33.20
Monday 25th hours commences with stormy winds from the S & steering N^W by N middle part rainy latter part more wind took in light sail
