Friday²⁴ There 24 hours fine
saw cappel E employed in boyling
middle part employed in boyling stowing
down latter part saw whales leaved
the starboard boat and struck

Saturday²⁵ There 24 hours fine
light boyling winds employed in
boyling and stowing down middle
part fine latter part calms finished
stowing saw three ships

Sunday²⁶ There 24 hours
commences with light winds from
the S^W saw cappel E dist 25 miles
the natives came of to us middle
part calms and some foggy

Monday²⁷ of May

There 24 hours commences with light
winds from the S^W employed in boyling
and stowing down middle and latter part
fine 20 ends

Tuesday²⁸ There 24 hours commences
with light winds from the S and some
foggy employed in boyling saw three
ships a stow in to the N 20 ends

Wednesday²⁹ There 24 hours commences
with light S winds and foggy
employed in boyling and stowing down
middle part passed Cappel E

Thursday³⁰ This day fine employed
in boyling and setting up shoals
middle and latter part clear

Friday³¹ There 24 hours light
winds from the S employed in
boyling and stowing down saw no
whales middle and latter part
clear 20 ends this day

Saturday¹ of June

There 24 hours light winds from
the S^W employed in boyling shook
the massachusetts middle and
latter part a working through the ice
latter part saw whales leaved and
the waist boat struck took him
a long side and cut him in 20 ends
