Shore 24 hours moderate winds from the N first part loaded a boat of St. Pauls and went a fishing but did not get any steered of S.E. at 9 p.m. saw St. Georges island and a large number of fore-backs middle part fine latter part saw two right whales loaded the boats and the waist boat struck killed him and he sunk in eighty fathom of water took the lines to the ship and hauled him up half of the way and the lines parted and lost him made sail and steered E.S.E.

Tuesday^d Shore 24 hours commenced with light winds from the S.W. a strong E.S.E. middle part the same at day light steered up to the S.E. winds a hallow to the S.

Wednesday^d Shore 24 hours commenced with strong winds and rain a strong sharp by to the S.E. first part saw the band to the E of Orinack passages at 8 p.m. it came in thick we ship and halled a back a huddy to the N.W. soundid and got 50 fathoms of water middle part foggy a standing of and on latter part the same

Thursday^d Shore 24 hours commenced with moderate winds from the W and a thick fog a standing of and on latter part it cleared up saw the land winds light at 10 a.m. came in rainy storm of strong winds took in light sail

Friday^d of Aug

Shore 24 hours commenced with light winds and rainy set all sail a strong sharp by winds from the S at 5 p.m. it cleared up and the wind halled to the W under the land on both sides of us steered E through the passages middle part halled up S.E. latter part winds halled to the S.S.W.

Saturday the 10 Shore 24 hours commenced with strong winds from the S.S.W. a strong sharp by to the S.E. first part took in royals and fore top gansail latter part moderate set all sail
