Monday² These 24 hours commence
with strong trades at 3 p.m. fetched by the point
steered of for diamonds ~~point~~ head at 5 p.m.
took a pilot at 6 the tug boat took us
in to the harbor furlled our sails so ends
the forenoon came off and took the men on shore

Tuesday³ These 24 hours commence
with fine weather all hands employed in
bundling bone and sending it on shore

Wednesday⁴ all hands employed
in bundling bone and storing it
on shore so ends

Thursday⁵ These 24 hours fine
discharged our seamen leaving three men
forward employed in bundling bone
and carrying carrying it on shore

Friday⁶ These 24 hours fine
all hands employed in bundling bone
latter part finished and stored it

Saturday⁷ These 24 hours commence
with fine weather discharged all of our
seamen and arrived so ends
