Sunday 15 commences with
fine wether and strong trades
latter part the capt arrived from
helen bay with the prisoners which
was sentenced one five years and
one two on the reef so ends

employed in bending sails
so ends this day

Tuesday 17 of Sept 1867

there 24 hours commences with
fine wether halled a long side of
the Beylon of in the steam

Wednesday 18 there 24 hours commences
with fine wether employed in discharging
oil on board of the Beylon

Thursday 19 there 24 hours commences
with fine wether employed in discharging
oil so ends

Friday 20 there 24 hours fine
employed in discharging oil on
board of the Beylon so ends

Saturday 21 there 24 hours fine
employed in discharging oil

Sunday 22 there 24 hours
commences with fine wether

Monday 23 there 24 hours
fine employed in discharging oil

Tuesday 24 fine halled a long
side of the warp and took in our
cask for ground and fresh water

Wednesday 25 this day fine
employed in stowing the ship
and taking water

Thursday 26 there 24 hours fine
employed in stowing and taking
water
