

Thursday 26th Dec 1857

There 24 hours commences with light winds a heddry in shore land dist 15 miles latter part employed in mending the old main top rail so ends

Friday 27th There 24 hours commences with light trades a heddry of shore employed in mending the old fore top rail latter part the island Magdalena dist 12 miles

Saturday 28th There 24 hours commences with light trades a heddry to the N-E middle part fine latter part bent a new fore sail and mended the old one and put it in a cask so ends

Sunday 29th There 24 hours commences with light winds a heddry to the E Magdalena dist 5 miles middle part fine a heddry to the N latter part saw St Pedro island so ends

Monday 30th There 24 hours commences with fine weather sent in a boat a fishing at St Pedro at 5 returned with a few fish middle part rainy latter part saw a bark the island dist 15 miles

Tuesday 31st Dec

There 24 hours commences with light winds at 4 pm spoke the bark Nautilus middle part rainy latter part calms land dist 15 miles

1st of January 1858

Wednesday 1st There 24 hours commences with light winds from the E a heddry to the N-E the Nautilus in sight middle part winds light at 9 am spoke the ship Lucia Crane of Lima bound to Otechita latter part rainy so ends

Thursday 2nd There 24 hours commences with light trades a story to the N at sun down shortened sail and heddry of shore land dist 10 miles middle part rainy latter part the same

Friday 3rd There 24 hours commences with light baffling and rainy middle part the same latter part the same so ends Land dist 15 miles

Saturday 4th There 24 hours commences with strong winds from the N under short sail saw the Nautilus a baffling latter part thick and rainy

Sunday 5th There 24 hours commences with strong winds from the N with same S Magdalena dist 20 miles middle part fine latter part the same all sail set the Nautilus in sight
