

Monday #6 of January 1868
These 24 hours commenced with
moderate trades & steering sharp
by saw the Nautilus & whaling
at 3 pm saw breeches run up for them
but saw nothing more of it land dist
15 miles latter part saw the Nautilus & cutting
and saw a strange bark

Tuesday 7 These 24 hours commenced
with moderate trades & heading to the
N employed in mending the fly gills
at 5 pm spoke the Emily Morgan forty
days from San Francisco and spoke the Nautilus
which had taken seven whals making 150 bls
latter part employed in mending the goft tops
two miles in sight land dist 15 miles

Wednesday 8 These 24 hours commenced
with light winds & standing to the E
at sun down took in the main sail
at day light made all sail saw two sails
to the windward and one of them a whaling
latter part fine land dist 20 miles

Thursday 9 These 24 hours commenced
with light trades & heading to the N B E
saw three sails and one a baying
middle part fine latter part the same

Friday 10 These 24 hours commenced
with light trades & working to the
windward saw two sails employed
in stowing down ~~sash~~ to put water in
middle part fine latter part
strong trades saw two sails
