Saturday 25 There 24 hours commences with strong trades a steering N<sup>W</sup> by N employed in bending royals and mending the main stay sail middle and latter part fine

Sunday 26 There 24 hours commences with strong trades middle part some rainy winds from the S.E. latter part moderate

Lat 6.17 Lg 145.00

Monday 27 There 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the S.E. a steering N<sup>W</sup> by W middle part winds light latter part strong squalls took in standing sails and main royal

Lat 8.10 Lg 146.30

Tuesday 28 There 24 hours commences with strong winds from the S.E. a steering N<sup>W</sup> middle part strong ~~winds~~ took in light sail latter part double reefed the topsails so ends

Wednesday 29 of Jan 1868

There 24 hours commences with strong winds from the N a steering N<sup>W</sup> middle part more moderate sail latter part clear employed in mending sails and other gobs

Thursday 30 There 24 hours commences with strong winds from the N.N.E a steering N<sup>W</sup> middle part the same latter part bent a new main sail and cut up the old one so ends

Friday 31 There 24 hours commences with strong winds from the N.N.E a steering N<sup>W</sup> by N middle part fine latter part winds light employed in taring the rigging

Saturday 1 of February

There 24 hours commences with light winds from the N a steering N<sup>W</sup> at 4 p.m. saw black fish looked for them but with ought success took in our cutting stage and bow boat to repair and set standing sails winds more to the E middle part winds baffling at day light saw oiler dist 40 miles

Sunday 2 There 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the S a steering to the W a long the land middle part rainy and baffling winds middle part the same latter part a steering down a long the land so ends
