Shine 24 hours commences with light winds and snow at 3 P.M. winds hauled to the N.E. steered N.W. by W. middle part strong winds took in light sail and doubled reefed the topsails and took the gale and main sail at day light. took in all sail and doubled reefed the main topsail. latter part a blowing heavy took in the main topsail & reefed

Sunday 22 Shine 24 hours commences with a heavy gale from the N. & heaving to the W. at 3 P.M. set the main topsail thick and snivy middle part was chop to the N.E. latter part some moderate snow

Monday 23 Shine 24 hours commences with a gale of wind from the N.W. & heaving to the N. at 4 more moderate middle part winds hauled to the S. steered N.W. by W. set some sail came in thick the watch employed in breaking the ice of the ship

To Observe

Tuesday 24 Shine 24 hours commences with strong winds from the S.E. & strong N.W. by W. thick and a snowing clout reefed the four topsails middle part clear

latter part fine set all sail winds light from the N.

Wednesday 25 of March 25

Shine 24 hours commences with light winds from the N.E. & strong N.W. killed two hogs middle part winds light latter part the same employed in breaking ought for water

Thursday 26 Shine 24 hours commences with fresh breeze from the S.E. & strong N.W. at 5 P.M. saw the ice 160 of March middle part strong winds of and on the ice at day light stood in to the ice came in thick stood of and shortened sail ice & making on the ship and very cold snow

Lat 61.05 Long 178.50 E. Long

Friday 27 Shine 24 hours commences with strong winds from the S. & heaving to the S.E. thick and very under short sail. latter part stood in to the ice snow

Lat 61.19 Long 176.11

Saturday 28 Shine 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the N.E. and clear & strong & long the ice to the W. saw a number of fin backs at sun down stood of at day light stood in to the ice to the N.W. saw the land middle and latter part fine ships in the ice saw no whales

Lat 61.19 Long 174.00 E.
