Shore 24 hours commences with light winds from the N^W & working through the ice to the S^W at sun down tacked to the N^W latter part came up to the ice that made on the shore land dist 30 miles

Thursdayth Shore 24 hours commences with light winds from the N^W & working through the ice to the N at sun down took in light sail and furled the courses middle and latter part fine & lying of the ice

Fridayth Shore 24 hours commences with light winds from the N^W & lying of the ice under short sail at day light set all sail winds light from the S^W & working through the ice in for the Cape 20 miles

Saturdayth Shore 24 hours commences with light winds from the S^W & steering for the Cape through the ice at 3 p.m. the wind hauled to the N^W & stood out of the ice and steered to the S & lying the ice at day light spoke the Onward and Ocean Massachusetts Regatta nothing this season latter part calms

Sundayth Shore 24 hours commences with light winds from the S at 4 p.m. all stood in to the ice and steered N^W & at 12 the wind left us middle part calms latter part light winds from the N^W in the ice & 20 miles

Mondayth April 19th 68

Shore 24 hours commences with light N^W winds all of the ships in the sectoring in at 6 the capt went on board of the Massachusetts took in all sail at 6 a.m. got caught in clear water at 7 a.m. a man fell from the pig boom over board hoared a boat and got him latter part set the topsails close reefed ran three sails 20 miles

Tuesdayth Shore 24 hours commences with strong gales from the N^W & heaving to the S took in the fore topsail middle part the same wor ship to the N latter part the same
