

Saturday 28 of April 1868

Shore 24 hours commences with light winds from the N a huddy to the S at 4 pm spoke the Ocean middle part calms at day light winds halled to the S Steered in to the N.E. through the ice in company with three other sails so ends

No observation

Sunday 29 Shore 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the S a steering to the N.E. at 3 pm came up to the heavy ice war ship to the S.E. and stood ongt latter part spoke the Ocean and Onward and Virginia

Monday 30 Shore 24 hours commences with light winds from the W a huy a back a gammy at 9 the capt came on board steered of to the S middle part five saw seven sails at 6 pm the capt went on board of the Gay head so ends Lat 60.50 L 17.40.00E

Tuesday 31 Shore 24 hours commences with light winds from the S.E. a huddy to the N.E. eight sails in sight at 9 pm the capt came on board middle part winds light at 8 pm the capt went on board of the Gay head latter part five

Lat 60.40 L 16.00.00

Wednesday 22 Shore 24 hours commences with light winds from the S a steering a long the ice in company with the gay head eight sails in sight middle and latter part five

Lat 60.50 L 17.10.00E

Thursday 23 of April

Shore 24 hours commences with light winds from the S.W. a huy of the ice a gammy with the Reinder middle part five latter part winds from the S.E. a steering a long the ice to the N.

Lat 60.59 L 17.40.30

Friday 24 Shore 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the S.E. a steering a long the ice to the N.E. at 3 pm stood in to the ice in company with the Eagle middle part a steering through the ice to the N.E. latter part a heavy swell a setting in from the S.E. steered ongt in a small place of clear water saw the Onward and gay head

Saturday 25 Shore 24 hours commences with strong winds from the N.E. a huy in the ice thick and cony middle part sounded and got thirty fathoms of water stood ongt to the S in clear water latter part joined with the gay head so ends

Sunday 26 Shore 24 hours commences with strong winds from the S with thick vether middle part clear saw the land dist fifteen miles latter part calms

Lat 61.40 L 17.50.00E

Monday 27 Shore 24 hours commences with light winds from the W a steering in to the N latter part the same
