

Monday 14 of Sept 1865

Shore 24 hours commences with strong winds from the E with foggy first part steering of N.W. and set sail at 10 p.m. shortened sail and layed a back a heading to the N.E. at 4 a.m. capt of N.W. and set sail thick foggy

No observation

Tuesday 15 Shore 24 hours commences with strong winds from the N.E. first part it cleared up a little saw the island of St. Mathews dist 10 miles at sun down took in light sail a heading to the N middle and latter part foggy no ends

Wednesday 16 Shore 24 hours commences with light winds from the E and a thick foggy a heading to the N middle and latter part the same a heading to the S.E. no ends

Thursday 17 Shore 24 hours commences with light winds from the E and foggy at 5 p.m. it lit up a little saw a sail run for her and it proved to be the *Ogenia* latter part foggy no ends

Friday 18 Shore 24 hours commences with light winds from the E and foggy took in the Red boat from of the harbour cranes and put on the old one at 2 p.m. saw St. Mathews dist ten miles middle part clear latter part foggy and calms caught fifty six coad fish no ends

Saturday 19 of Sept

Shore 24 hours commences with calms and a thick foggy at 2 p.m. it cleared a little saw the land dist ten miles middle part foggy latter part calms caught several odd fish no ends a thick fog

Sunday 20 Shore 24 hours commences with a thick foggy and calms at 7 light winds from the N.E. steered to S.E. latter part it steered up winds halled to N steered S.E. saw a sail a stern of us

Monday 21 Shore 24 hours commences with strong winds from the N.E. steering S.E. at 2 p.m. took in light sail and doubled reefed the topsails at 4 p.m. halled to the wind a blowing strong took in all sail except in last reefed main topsail middle part strong winds latter part more moderate

Tuesday 22 Shore 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the N.E. a strong S.E. middle part halled to the wind thick foggy latter part the same under short sail a heading to the E no ends
