

Friday² of Oct 1868

These 24 hours commences with light winds from the N. a steering S.E. at sun down halled to and took in light sail at 4 am set sail and steered of for seventy two passage S by E St Georges island in sight latter part strong wind from the N.W. the gary in sight

Lat 46.13 Long 166.10

Saturday³ These 24 hours commences with strong winds from the N.W. a steering S by E middle part fine latter part the same employed in sending up the four top gannal yard and royal yard and sail

Sunday⁴ These 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the N.W. a steering S by E at 4 am took in the bow and waist boat on deck saw the land to the E of seventy two passage dist fifty miles middle part fine at 4 am passed through the passage steered S.E. latter part spook the gary and the capt came on board no winds

Lat 51.49 Long 170.59

Monday⁵ These 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the N.W. a steering S.E. at 5 p.m. the capt went on board of his ship middle part strong winds and squally employed in sending down the cutting cables the gary in sight a steering S.E.

Lat 47.18 Long 171

Tuesday⁶ of Oct 1868

These 24 hours commences with strong winds from the N.W. a steering S.E. middle part strong winds latter part set studding sails the gary a stern of us

Lat 46.13 Long 166.10

Wednesday⁷ These 24 hours commences with strong winds from the N.W. a steering S.E. middle part some squally latter part the same winds from the W. no winds

Lat 43.10 Long 164.59

Thursday⁸ These 24 hours commences with strong winds from the W. a steering S.E. middle part winds light latter part winds halled to the N. shifted over studding sails employed in a few gobs about the ship

Lat 41.20 Long 164.04

Friday⁹ These 24 hours commences with light winds from the N.W. a steering S.E. middle part more wind with rain took in light sail latter part a blowing heavy from the N.E. took in all sail exceptin clost reefed main top sail and steered S.E.

Saturday¹⁰ These 24 hours commences with the winds more moderate and a heavy sea a running at sun down we set some sail middle part wind from the E latter part strong winds and a heavy sea no winds
