from the N latter part employed
in fitting rigging no arrivals

Tuesday²⁰ There 24 hours
commenced with moderate winds
from the N a steering S by W
at 3 pm saw Oahu dist 30 miles
and saw a large middle part
took in light sail and run
down of diamond head at
day light closed in at 6 AM
took the pilot at 8 AM took
the steamer at 9 anchored
and on bent our sails and
discharged the scow no arrivals

Wednesday²¹ This day fine
what few we have belonging to the
ship at work fitting rigging several
arrivals from the arch with a fair
season catch

Thursday²² There 24 hours
employed in fitting rigging middle
and latter part fine several
arrivals one steamer from
the frisco

Friday²³ of Oct 1868

This day fine employed in getting
ready to take freight from the Gay head
middle and latter part fine
several arrivals no arrivals

Saturday²⁴ There 24 hours
fine the gay head halled a long side
of us hired eight men from the shore
to work broke out the after hole
and fore hole no arrivals

Sunday²⁵ There 24 hours fine
no arrivals all hands on shore
on shore except one man and
an officer on board light winds from
the S latter part fine

Monday²⁶ There 24 hours commenced
with fine weather employed in taking
oil from the Gay head middle and
latter part fine

Tuesday²⁷ There 24 hours commenced
with fine weather employed in taking
freight from the gay head no arrivals

Wednesday²⁸ This day fine
employed in taking freight from
the Gay head middle and latter
part fine light winds from
the S no arrivals
