Saturday #12 Shore of houses strong winds from the E & steering S by E employed in stowing & wa recruits middle part strong winds latter part fine no ends

Sunday #13 Shore of houses commences with strong winds from the E & steering S by E middle part fine latter part almost hall to the winds

Monday #14 Shore of houses commences with light winds from the E & heading sharp by to the S latter part fine winds light

Tuesday #15 Shore of houses commences with light trades & heading south middle part fine latter part calm employed in ships duty

Wednesday #16 of Dec 1868

Shore of houses commences with calms at 5 am light winds from the S W middle part calms latter part winds light and baffling

Thursday #17 Shore of houses commences with light winds from the S W & heading to the S E

Latter part fine employed in ships duty no ends

Lat 30° 12' Long 159° 38'

Friday #18 Shore of houses commences with moderate winds from the S & heading to the E middle part the same moderate latter part

Saturday #19 Shore of houses commences with strong winds from the S & heading to the E middle part took in light sail winds

Sunday #20 Shore of houses commences with strong winds from the S & heading sharp by to the E middle part more moderate latter part employed in setting up rigging war ship to the S W
