Commenced with light air from the southward & fine weather heading to the E.S.E. employed about cundry jobs middle part light air & variable heading from E.S.E. at daylight tacked ship to the S.W. all sail set last part light breezes from the southward heading to the W.S.W. employed in breaking out in the main hold for cordage & various things occurs No Observations

Saturday January 14th

Commenced with light breezes from the S.S.W. wore ship to the S.E. employed in breaking out & stowing down in the main hold at 4 PM. finished & stowed off middle part light air & variable heading from W.S.W. last part light breezes from the E.S.E. heading S.W. employed about cundry jobs sent a fore spencer occurs

Commenced with light breezes from the westward steering south the watch employed in rearing new reef ladders and chelines and various jobs of ships duty middle part moderate breezes from the S.S.E. at midnight wore ship to the W.S.W. all sail set last part moderate breezes from the S.S.E. and clear weather heading up by the wind on the larboard tack to the S.W. occurs

Commenced with fresh breezes from the S.S.E. & fine weather heading S.W. employed about various jobs of ships duty middle part moderate breezes from the S.S.E. heading S.W. last part moderate breezes from the southward and cloudy heading by the wind to the S.W. all sail set the watch employed about various jobs of ships duty occurs

Commenced with moderate breezes from the southward and cloudy weather heading to the S.W. all sail set middle part fresh breezes from the southward heading S.W. last part strong breezes from the S.S.E. and clear weather heading by the wind to the S.W. a brig in sight to the leeward steering S.W. by W. occurs
