

Sunday March 11th 1854

Commences with fresh breezes from the westward and thick weather. Heading S.W. & under close reefed top sails and reefed courses and jib. middle part moderate breezes from W.S.W. at 2 o'clock the wind hauled to the southward wore ship to the N.W. and made sail with light air. Lat 57-52 Last part light air from E.S.E. and fine weather. Lon 73-30 steering from W.S.W. to W. all drawing sail out soon.

Monday March 12th

Commences with light air from the eastward and fine weather steering West all drawing sail out. middle part light breezes from N.E. to S. steering West. Lat 57-50 Last part moderate breezes from N.W. and thick weather. Lon 75-55 heading up on the starboard tack to S.W. soon.

Tuesday March 13th

Commences with moderate breezes from the N.W. and thick weather. Heading up by the wind on the starboard tack S.W. & all sail set at 6 o'clock. Took in the top gallant sails & double reefed the top sails. middle part strong breezes from the N.W. and thick weather. Heading up on the starboard tack W.S.W. at 6 o'clock the wind hauled to the W.S.W. wore ship to the N.W. and made sail with fine weather. Lat 58-57 Last part fresh breezes from W.S.W. heading N.W. soon.

Wednesday March 14th

Commences with fresh breezes from the westward and fine weather. Heading by the wind to the N.W. middle part fresh breezes from West heading N.W. Lat 58-52 Last part strong breezes from the westward heading by the wind to the N.W. soon.

Thursday March 15th 1854

Commences with strong breezes from the westward and clear weather. Heading to the N.W. at 1 o'clock more ship to the S.W. took in the main top gallant sail at 2 o'clock. double reefed the top with strong breezes from W.S.W. middle part strong breezes & squally from W.S.W. heading N.W. under double reefed top sails and courses. Lat 58-47 Last part fresh breezes from S.W. and fine weather steering N.W. all sail out saw a ship & dark heading to the S.E. soon.

Friday March 16th

Commences with fresh breezes from S.W. and fine weather steering N.W. all sail out employed about various jibs. middle part strong breezes from the southward with squalls of snow & hail took in the light sails steering N.W. Lat 58-55 Last part strong breezes from the southward steering N.W. all sail out soon.

Saturday March 17th

Commences with moderate breezes from the southward and fine weather steering N.W. all sail out. middle part strong breezes from the southward with squalls of hail & snow steering N.W. all drawing sail out. Lat 48-44 Last part fresh southerly winds & squally steering N.W. soon.

Sunday March 18th

Commences with fresh breezes from the south and cloudy weather steering North all drawing sail out. middle part light breezes from the southward at 1 o'clock the wind hauled to the westward the ship heading North. Lat 46-37 Last part moderate breezes from the N.W. & cloudy weather heading by the wind to the N.E. soon.
