

Thursday May 24th

Commences with moderate trade winds from S.E. steering West all sail set at sunset luffed to the wind up S.W. and took in the light sails & main sail middle part light sails at midnight were close to the E.N.E. at daylight were again to the westward last part light sails from the S.E. and fine weather steering W.S. employed in painting the Starboard boat and various jobs of ship's duty occurs

Friday May 25th

Commences with light trade winds from the S.E. steering W.S. employed about sundry jobs at sunset luffed to the wind up S.W. and took in the light sails middle part light sails and calms heading S.W. last part light sails from the eastward heading to the S.W. employed in painting the waist boat and various jobs of ship's duty occurs

Saturday May 26th

Commences with light airs from the E.S.E. heading to the S.W. employed about sundry jobs of ship's duty middle part light sails from N.W.E. steering S. last part light sails from the northward and fine weather steering S.E. employed about sundry jobs

Sunday May 27th

Commences with light airs from the northward and fine weather steering south middle part calm heading to the southward last part light airs from the S.E. heading to the E.N.E. saw Blackfish lowered and caught three occurs employed about the Blackfish



Monday May 28th 1854

Commences with light breezes from the S.E. heading to the E.N.E. at 4 o'clock luffed ship to the S.W. saw finbacks middle part fresh breezes and rugged took in the light sails last part fresh breezes from the S.E. steering W.S. employed in boiling out blackfish occurs

Tuesday May 29th

Commences with fresh breezes from the S.E. and rugged steering from W.S. to N.E. at sunset double reefed the top sails furled jib and main sail heading S.W. middle part fresh breezes and rugged heading to the S.W. at midnight were close to the E.N.E. with fresh breezes last part more moderate turned the reefs out of the top sails & set the main top gallant sail steering N.W.E. saw finbacks at 11 A.M. saw a ship heading to the S.W. occurs

Wednesday May 30th

Commences with fresh breezes from the S.E. heading by the wind to the Eastward employed about sundry jobs at sunset took the main sail & main top gallant sail middle part moderate breezes from S.E. heading E.N.E. last part moderate breezes from the S.E. and cloudy weather heading to the E.N.E. employed about sundry jobs of ship's duty No Observations occurs

Thursday May 31st

Commences with moderate breezes from the S.E. and cloudy weather heading up on the Starboard tack E.N.E. at sunset took in the light sails middle part moderate breezes & cloudy weather heading E.N.E. last part moderate breezes from the S.E. heading N.E. the watch employed about ship's duty occurs No Observations
