

Friday May 21<sup>st</sup> 1854


Commences with light trade winds from E.S.E. with thick disagreeable weather steering north at sunset took in the light sails fore and main sails and kept her N.W. with thick weather middle part light breezes at daylight kept her with last part light trades & cloudy handy in with the land steering N.W. employed about the rigging & various jobs

Saturday May 22<sup>nd</sup>

Commences with light trade winds from the S.E. steering N.W. handy in with the land employed about various jobs at sunset took in the gibs steering N.W. middle part moderate breezes steering W. by N. last part moderate trades from E.S.E. and clear weather steering W. by N. employed about the rigging & various jobs

Lat 16-20

Sunday May 23<sup>rd</sup>

Commences with fresh trade winds & fine weather steering N.W. handy in with the land at sunset took in the light sails & double reefed the top sails middle part moderate breezes steering W. by N. last part light breezes & fine weather steering from W.S.W. to N.W. by W. handy in with the land saw black fish lowered and caught two seen 

Lat 15-42

Monday May 24<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light airs & fine weather steering N.W. by W. handy in with the land middle part light breezes steering N.W. by W. last part light trades from the eastward steering West employed about the rigging and various jobs seen handy in with the land saw a sail steering N.W.

Lat 14-48

Tuesday May 25<sup>th</sup> 1854

Commences with light breezes from the eastward steering N.W. by W. handy in with the land employed in pulling out black fish at 10 P.M. saw black fish lowered & caught two small ones at sunset took in the light sails a big one in sight steering E.N.E. middle part moderate trades steering N.W. by W. at 10 P.M. shifted to the wind on the larboard tack with the main top-sail aback last part moderate trades from the S.E. steering N.W. by W. employed in pulling out black fish saw hump back too

Lat 15-58

Wednesday May 26<sup>th</sup>

Commences with moderate trade winds from the S.E. steering N.W. by W. handy in with the land saw a fleet of ships at anchor at the Phoenix Islands middle part light breezes steering N.W. by W. handy in with the land last part light airs from the eastward steering N.W. by W. with five sails in sight seen handy in with the land

Thursday May 27<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light airs from the E.S.E. steering N.W. by W. at 10 P.M. the Captain went on shore with the boat at Callao at 5 P.M. the boat came on board again stood off S.W. under top-sail middle part light airs & calms trying to work to seaward last part calm laying off Callao day seen

Friday May 28<sup>th</sup>

Commences with a calm laying off Callao day at 10 P.M. took a light breeze and headed in for the shipping middle part light airs laying off 4 m at Callao last part calm at 8 P.M. sent a boat on shore for the Capt at 10 P.M. came on board took up the boat (lay in in the day becalmed seen)
