

Tuesday August 29th 1854

Commenced with light breezes from the northward.
employed in painting the ship out side
middle & last part calm later part employed in
painting the ship in side one watch ashore on Liberty soon

Wednesday August 30th

Commenced with moderate trades & clear weather.
the watch employed in painting the ship in side
middle part light breezes & fine weather
last part light was employed in painting the ship
one watch ashore on Liberty soon

Thursday August 31st

Commenced with fresh breezes employed in painting
ship one watch ashore on Liberty
middle & last parts calm & fine weather soon

Friday September 1st 1854

Commenced with fresh trades & fine weather.
employed in painting ship one watch ashore on Liberty
middle part fresh breezes and clear weather
last part light breezes & fine weather employed
about various jobs one watch ashore soon

Saturday September 2^d

Commenced with strong breezes employed about
various jobs one watch ashore on Liberty soon

Sunday September 3^d

Commenced with strong breezes & fine weather
one watch ashore on Liberty
middle and last part moderate breezes soon

Monday September 4th 1854

Commenced with fresh trades & fine weather
one watch ashore on Liberty
middle & last part light breezes one watch ashore
on Liberty soon

Tuesday September 5th

Commenced with fresh trades one watch ashore
middle and last parts fresh breezes & clear weather soon

Wednesday September 6th

Commenced with fresh trades one watch ashore on Liberty
middle part light airs at midnight Francis Cutler
and John Smith came away from the ship & deserted
last part light breezes at 10 or 11 AM. took our anchor and
stood off to the westward the Captain on shore soon

Thursday September 7th

Commenced with fresh breezes from the S.E. heading to the
westward under top sails and fore sail jib & spanker
middle part fresh breezes and thick weather heading to the S.W.
at midnight wore ship to the E.N.E. with thick weather
last part fresh trades heading to the Eastward a sail in sight
to windward soon

Lat 5° 49'
Lon 81° 17'

Friday September 8th

Commenced with fresh trades from the southward heading
to the E.S.E. at 4 or 5 PM. lashed ship to the westward standing
in with the land at dusk spoke the Bark Montrose one of the Regt
middle part moderate breezes and thick weather
last part fresh trades and thick weather heading to
the wind to the eastward employed in breaking out for
provisions and various jobs soon
