Commences with moderate trades from the S.E. and fine weather at 10 P.M. tacked ship to the E.N.E. saw humpbacks middle part light breezes heading to the eastward last part light breezes at 10 A.M. tacked ship to the south saw black fish. Lowered with out success seen

Monday September 18th

Commences with light trades from the S.E. heading to the wind to the E.N.E. saw finbacks & humpbacks middle part fresh breezes heading E.S.W. last part light breezes from the S.E. heading to the wind to the E.N.E. at 11 A.M. wore ship to the S.W. handy in with the land seen

Lat 5-12

Tuesday September 19th

Commences with moderate trade winds from S.E. at 10 P.M. wore ship to the eastward at 4 P.M. the Captain went on shore with the boat at Paia middle part laying off and on at Paia last part light air and calm at 10 A.M. sent a boat on shore for the Captain at 11 came on board with the steward from the calaboose took up the boat & stood off N.W. seen

Wednesday September 20th

Commences with fresh trade winds from the S.E. steering N.W. at sunset took in the light sails & main sail huffed to the wind in S.W. middle part fresh breezes and thick weather heading S.W. last part moderate trades & foggy weather steering W. by N. saw whaleing bark heading to the eastward seen

Lat 6-17

Thursday September 21st 1854

Commences with moderate trade winds from the southward steering W. by N. the watch employed about sundown got on humpbacks & finbacks at sunset took in the light sails heading W. by N. middle part moderate breezes at midnight wore ship to the eastward last part moderate trades steering N.W. saw a plenty of finbacks seen

Lat 3-30

Friday September 22nd

Commences with light airs and calms heading N. by E. at sunset took in the light sails and main sail middle part light breezes heading to the westward last part light breezes from the S.E. W. and thick weather heading to the wind to the westward seen. No observations

Saturday September 23rd

Commences with light air from the S.E. heading to the westward saw black fish. Lowered for them with out success middle part light breezes & fine weather heading N.E. by E. last part light breezes and thick weather steering N.W. seen

Lat 2-27
Lon 86-17

Sunday September 24th

Commences with moderate trades from the S.E. and fine weather steering west a sail in sight to the seaward at sunset took in the light sails & main sail heading S.W. by W. middle part moderate breezes & fine weather heading S.W. last part moderate trades & cloudy steering west seen

Lat 2-28

Monday September 25th

Commences with moderate trade winds from the S.E. steering W. by N. saw black fish. Lowered and caught one at sunset took in the light sails & main sail heading S.W. middle part moderate at midnight wore ship to the eastward last part light breezes and cloudy weather steering W. by N. the watch employed about sundown got on seen. No observations
