Commences with moderate trade winds steering E. by N. handy in with the north side of Abornale Island middle part moderate breezes steering N. E.

Last part fresh trades from S. S. E. heading by the wind to the eastward Abington & Bendloe Islands in sight

Lat 00-57 to the windward occurs

Friday October 11th

Commences with fresh trade winds from S. S. E. and fine weather heading by the wind to the eastward at sunset tacked ship to the S. W. all sail set middle part fresh trades at 10 P.M. tacked to the eastward

at daylight tacked ship to the S. W. with fresh breezes last part fresh trades and rugged at 10 or 11 A.M. tacked

Lat 00-43 ship to the eastward off Abington Island occurs

Saturday October 12th

Commences with fresh trade winds from the S. S. E. heading to the eastward Bendloe & Abington Islands in sight

middle part fresh trades heading to the eastward

Last part strong trades & rugged heading to the E. S. E. even

Sunday October 13th

Commences with fresh trade winds from the southward heading by the wind to the E. S. E. with cloudy weather

at sunset tacked ship to the W. S. W. with fresh breezes

middle part moderate breezes & cloudy weather

Last part light trades & fine weather occurs

Monday October 14th

Commences with light trades from the southward heading W. S. W. Down & Bendloe Islands in sight at 5 or 6 P.M. tacked ship to the E. S. E.

middle part moderate breezes heading to the eastward

Last part moderate trades from the S. S. E. heading E. by S.

Lat 00-33 employed in breaking out & stowing down oil in the main hold occurs

Tuesday October 10th 1854

Commences with moderate trade winds from the S. S. E. heading by the wind to the eastward employed in stowing down oil in the main hold at 4 or 5 P.M. finished & washed off the decks middle part moderate breezes and cloudy weather heading E. by S.

Lat 00-41 Last part light trades & cloudy weather heading by the wind

to the E. S. E. employed in breaking out in the fore hold occurs

Wednesday October 11th

Commences with moderate trade winds from the S. S. E. and cloudy weather heading by the wind to the eastward at sunset tacked ship to the W. S. W. with light breezes middle part moderate breezes and cloudy weather

Lat 00-19 Last part moderate trades & fine weather heading S. by E.

Lat 00-16 the watch employed about various jobs of ship's duty occurs

Thursday October 12th

Commences with fresh trade winds from the S. S. E. heading to the wind to the S. W. Chatham Island in sight off the weather bow at 5 or 6 P.M. tacked ship to the eastward

middle part moderate breezes heading to the eastward

at daylight tacked ship to the W. S. W. Chatham Island in sight

Last part fresh trades heading by the wind to the W. S. W. employed

Lat 00-07 in repairing sails & various jobs occurs

Friday October 13th

Commences with moderate trade winds from the southward heading by the wind to the W. S. W. Chatham & Hoods Islands in sight at 5 or 6 P.M. wore ship to the E. S. E. Hoods Island bearing S. S. E. 20 mi. dis.

middle part light breezes at 8 or 10 A.M. tacked ship to the S. W.

Last part moderate trades from the S. S. E. steering from

W. to W. S. W. handy in with Hoods Island employed in
