

Sunday, October 22^d 1854

Commences with light trades and fine weather heading to the eastward employed in boiling Wenmans Island. At noon middle part moderate breezes with squalls of rain heading to the eastward employed in boiling at 2 P.M. wore ship to the S.W. Last part moderate trades & fine weather at 8 P.M. wore ship to the eastward employed in boiling at noon finished boiling coals

Monday October 23^d

Commences with moderate trades from the southward heading to the E.S.E. the north east point of Abemarle bearing S.E. 20 miles middle part light airs heading to the eastward last part light breezes heading to the E.S.E. Rodondo Rock bearing S.E. 12 miles Abington Island bearing E by N. 20 miles and

Tuesday, October 24th

Commences with light airs from the southward heading to the eastward Abington in sight at 4 P.M. saw a sail to the windward at sunset Rodondo Rock bore S.W. 15 miles middle part fresh breezes heading to the eastward last part fresh trades from the S.E. at 7 P.M. wore ship to the S.W. handy in with Abington Island seen

Wednesday October 25th

Commences with light breezes from the S.E. heading to the S.W. Rodondo Rock in sight at 2 P.M. saw a sail to the leeward at sunset Rodondo bore S.W. 8 miles at 8 P.M. spoke Park Montgomery of New Bedford middle part light breezes heading to the eastward last part light trades & fine weather heading to the S.W. off Rodondo Rock seen

Thursday, October 26th 1854

Commences with moderate trades from the southward & fine weather heading to the E.S.E. at sunset tacked ship to the S.W. Rodondo Rock bore N.W. 10 miles the north head of Abemarle S.E. 6 miles middle part light breezes off Rodondo Rock last part light airs and calms employed in stowing down oil handy in with the north part of Abemarle Island seen

Friday October 27th

Commences with light breezes from the S.W. steering E by S employed in stowing down oil in the fore hold at 4 P.M. finished and washed off the decks at sunset handy in on the east side of Abemarle steering S.E. by E with a light breeze from N.W. middle part light airs and calms heading to the eastward last part calm. Abington, James, Bendloes and Abemarle Islands in sight seen

Saturday, October 28th

Commences with light airs from the S.E. heading to the E.N.E. at sunset Abington bore N.W. 20 miles Bendloes E by S. 12 miles middle part light breezes from S.E. heading to the eastward last part moderate trades from S.E. heading E.N.E. Bendloes & Dowers Islands in sight seen

Sunday, October 29th

Commences with light trade winds from S.E. heading East at sunset Dowers Island bore S.W. 12 miles distant middle part moderate breezes & cloudy heading to the eastward last part moderate trades at 2 P.M. tacked ship to the S.W. at 8 P.M. tacked again to the eastward at noon tacked to the S.W. with light breezes & cloudy seen
