

Saturday December 22nd 1854

Commences with fresh trade winds from the S.E. and rugged at sunset were ship to the W.S.W. middle part strong breezes heading to the W.S.W. last part moderate trades heading by the wind
Lat 00° 50' N. W. employed in stowing down oil casks

Sunday December 23rd

Commences with fresh trade winds from the south and fine weather heading by the wind to the W.S.W. middle part fresh breezes heading to the W.S.W. last part strong trades and rugged heading
Lat 00° 25' N. W. took in the main top gallant or I oars

Monday December 24th

Commences with fresh trade winds from the southward heading by the wind up S.E. light middle part moderate breezes heading W.S.W. at daylight saw Chatham Island bearing S.E. 20 m. last part fresh trades & calms steering from W.S.W.
Lat 00° 31' N. W. employed about various jobs oars

Tuesday December 25th

Commences with light airs & variable at 10 P.M. fresh trades from the southward heading from W. to S.W. at sunset tacked ship to the E.S.E. - Barrington Island bearing S.E. 30 miles at midnight tacked to the S.E. W. last part moderate breezes & calms steering N.W.
Lat 00° 19' N. W. handy in with Porters Island oars

Wednesday December 26th

Commences with moderate trade winds from the S. steering W.S.W. employed about various jobs middle part calm handy in with James Island last part moderate breezes steering N.
Lat 00° 16' N. the mate sick oars

Thursday December 27th 1854

Commences with moderate trade winds from the S.E. steering from N. to W.W. employed about various jobs middle part moderate breezes off with head of Albemarle last part light airs & calms off Lee Bay saw a sail to the southward saw blackfish & finbacks oars

Friday December 28th

Commences with moderate trade winds off Harbours at 3 P.M. spoke Bark Catherwood of Whitport 15 ms 250 spm middle part calm laying off Harbours last part light breezes the Catherwood in sight saw finbacks oars the mate sick

Saturday December 29th

Commences with light trade winds off weather bag at 3 P.M. spoke the Catherwood heading to the E.S.E. middle part light airs laying aback off Lee Bay last part moderate trades & fine weather steering with the Catherwood in sight oars

Sunday December 30th

Commences with moderate trade winds from S.E. steering N. the Catherwood in sight at sunset luffed to the wind up E.S.E. with the fore top sail aback Orlando Rock bearing E.S.E. 4 miles distant middle part laying aback at daylight kept her north
Lat 00° 35' N. last part moderate trades steering N. the Catherwood in sight

Monday December 31st

Commences with moderate trade winds steering N. at 3 P.M. spoke Bark Catherwood middle part laying aback heading to the E.S.E. last part fresh trades steering N.E. by E. the Catherwood in sight Penmans Island bearing N.E. 20 miles oars
