

Tuesday December 12th 1854

Commences with moderate trade winds from S.E. & handy in with Wenman's Island at 1 P.M. a boat went in for fish. The Catherwood in company at 3 P.M. the boat came on board. Breeze fell to the middle part light breezes working to windward. Last part moderate trades & fine weather heading to the eastward handy in with Wenman's Island. The Catherwood in sight stern over the mate sick.

Wednesday December 13th

Commenced with moderate trade winds from the S.E. heading to the eastward off Wenman's Island. Middle part light airs with squalls of rain. Last part fresh breezes heading to the W.S.W. Wenman's Island in sight at 10 A.M. Tacked ship to the eastward. The Catherwood in sight over.

Thursday December 14th

Commences with light trade winds from the S.E. heading to the eastward at 4 P.M. spoke Bark Catherwood at sunset Wenman's Island 10 W by N. 20 miles. Middle part light breezes heading to the eastward. Last part moderate trades & fine weather heading up on the starboard tack from E. to S. by E. The Bark Catherwood in sight over.

Friday December 15th

Commences with light trades from the S.E. heading by the wind to the eastward. The Catherwood in sight. Middle part light breezes heading to the eastward. Last part moderate trades at 9 A.M. Tacked ship to the S.W. at noon tacked again to the eastward over.

Saturday December 16th 1854

Commences with light trade winds from the S.E. heading to the eastward at 2 P.M. spoke the Catherwood. Middle part light trades heading to the eastward. Last part moderate breezes heading by the wind to the eastward. The Catherwood in sight over.

Sunday December 17th

Commenced with light breezes & buffing with thick rainy weather heading to the eastward. Middle part moderate breezes heading to the E.S.E. Last part light trades & cloudy heading to the eastward. The Bark Catherwood in sight. Found the mate sick.

Monday December 18th

Commences with moderate trade winds from the S.E. heading to the eastward. The Catherwood in sight. Middle part fresh breezes & squally heading to the E.S.E. Last part fresh trades & rugged heading by the wind to the E.S.E. Took in the main top gallant sail over.

Tuesday December 19th

Commences with fresh trade winds from the southward heading by the wind on the starboard tack up E.S.E. Middle part fresh breezes heading to the eastward. Last part moderate trades from the S.E. heading by the wind to the E.S.E. The watch employed about various jobs over the mate sick.

Wednesday December 20th

Commences with moderate trade winds from the S.E. and fine weather heading to the eastward. Middle part moderate trades heading E.S.E. Last part moderate trade winds & fine weather heading to the E.S.E. The watch employed about various jobs of ship's duty over.
