Lon 82-28 tacked ship to the W. S. W. at noon tacked again to the E. S. E. over

Tuesday December 26th

Commences with fresh breezes from the southward heading by the wind on the starboard tack to the E. S. E.

middle part moderate breezes & fine weather heading S. E.

last part light breezes & fine weather heading to the
Lat 2-38^N wind to the E. S. E. employed in getting masting & rigging
Lon 81-28 and various jobs of ships duty over

Wednesday December 27th

Commences with moderate breezes from the S. S. W. heading up on the starboard tack to the S. E.

middle part light breezes at 8 PM. wore ship to the S. W.

at daylight saw the land & a ship at anchor off Sumbar

last part light air from the N. W. W. heading in for Sumbar
at noon came to anchor off Sumbar in 4 fathoms water over
