

Saturday December 23<sup>rd</sup> 1854

Commences with light breezes from the westward employed about various jobs of ship's duty middle part calm and fine weather last part light airs from the northward employed in getting off wood & potatoes oven

Sunday December 24<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light breezes from the N.W. & fine weather middle part calm with fine weather last part light airs from the N.E. & fine weather at 6 or 7 AM. took our anchor from Lumber and stood off to the westward oven

Monday January 1<sup>st</sup> 1855

Commences with light breezes from the westward heading up on the starboard tack to the S.E. at 10 AM. passed a merchant ship steering N.E. middle part light airs and calm making the ship to the southward handy in with the land last part light airs from the N.W. heading to the S.W. the watch employed about various jobs of Lumber

Tuesday January 2<sup>nd</sup>

Commences with light breezes from the W.S.W. heading by the wind to the southward at 5 or 6 PM. tacked ship to the N.W. middle part light airs and calm last part light airs from N.W. to W.S.W. employed in working the ship to the southward & sundry jobs of ship's duty. Three sails in sight oven handy in with the land

Wednesday January 3<sup>rd</sup> 1855

Commences with moderate breezes from the S.W. & fine weather employed in working the ship to the southward handy in with the land three sails in sight middle part moderate breezes from the S.E. heading by the wind to the westward at 4 or 5 PM. tacked ship to the S.E. last part light breezes from the S.E. heading by the wind to the S.E. at noon tacked ship to the westward oven

Thursday January 4<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light breezes from the S.E. heading to the westward at 10 or 11 PM. tacked ship to the S.E. at 4 or 5 AM. wore ship to the W.S.W. handy in with the land middle part light airs from the S.E. heading to the S.W. last part light breezes from the S.E. at 8 or 9 AM. wore ship to the eastward saw blackfish toward & caught six ovens

Friday January 5<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light airs from the S.E. heading up by the wind to the S.E. employed about the blackfish middle part light breezes from the S.E. heading to the S.W. last part light breezes from the S.E. heading to the eastward the land in sight & a brig in sight to the seaward ovens

Saturday January 6<sup>th</sup>

Commences with moderate breezes from the S.E. heading up by the wind to the S.E. handy in with the land at 5 or 6 PM. the Capt went on shore at Payta middle part light airs laying off & on at Payta last part light breezes laying off & on oven

Sunday January 7<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fresh trades at 1 or 2 PM. the Capt came on board middle part moderate breezes heading by the wind to the S.W. last part light airs heading from S.E. W. to S.W. saw blackfish oven
