larboard tack S. S. W. the ship George & Susan in sight
middle part moderate trades heading to the S. S. W.
last part moderate trades & fine weather heading
by the wind to the S. S. W. the watch employed about
various jobs the ship George & Susan in sight & round the mate sick

Tuesday January 5th 1856

Lat 13-42
Lon 89-42 Commences with light trade winds from the S. E.
at 100 P.M. tacked ship to the E. S. E. the ship George & Susan in
sight at 300 tacked again to the S. S. W.
middle part moderate trades heading to the S. S. W.
last part moderate trades from the S. E. & fine
weather heading by the wind to the S. S. W. the watch
employed about various jobs of ship's duty the ship
George & Susan in sight ahead & round the mate sick
