Commenced with light trade winds from the S.E. and fine weather heading up by the wind on the larboard tack from S.W. to S.S.W. The ship George & Susan of New Bedford in sight ahead. The watch employed about mid

middle part moderate trades & fine weather  
Lat 16-13<sup>W</sup> Last part light trade winds from the eastward  
Lon 84-59 heading up by the wind from S. to S.S.E. scene

Thursday January 18<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with light trade winds from the E.S.E. heading to southward the ship George & Susan in sight middle part moderate trades heading to the S.S.W. Last part light trades from the E.S.E. and fine

weather heading by the wind to the southward  
Lat 16-30<sup>W</sup> The George & Susan in sight to windward scene  
Lon 90-30

Friday January 19<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with moderate trade winds from the E.S.E. heading up by the wind on the larboard tack south the ship George & Susan in sight to the windward middle part moderate trades heading to the south. Last part fresh breezes & squally. Cook in the

light sails & set up the main top gallant backstay  
Lat 17-57<sup>W</sup> the ship George & Susan in sight scene  
Lon 91-20

Saturday January 20<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fresh trade winds from the E.S.E. heading by the wind to the southward the ship George & Susan in sight at sunset took in the light sails middle part strong breezes & squally double reefed the top-sails heading up S.S.E.

Last part strong breezes from the eastward turned the reefs out of the main top sail  
Lat 17-9<sup>W</sup> heading up by the wind on the larboard tack S.S.E.  
Lon 91-50 the George & Susan in sight scene

Sunday January 21<sup>st</sup> 1855

Commenced with fresh breezes from the eastward heading up by the wind on the larboard tack S.S.E. the ship George & Susan of New Bedford in sight middle part fresh breezes & squally heading S.S.E.

Lat 20-51<sup>W</sup> Last part strong breezes from the E.S.E. heading  
Lon 92-38 to the southward scene

Monday January 22<sup>nd</sup>

Commenced with fresh breezes from the eastward and rugged heading by the wind on the larboard tack up S.S.E. the ship George & Susan in sight middle part strong breezes & squally heading south

Lat 22-11<sup>W</sup> Last part fresh breezes from E.S.E. heading by the wind  
Lon 92-33 to the southward under single reefed top sails & courses over

Tuesday January 23<sup>rd</sup>

Commenced with fresh breezes from the eastward heading by the wind to the southward under single reefed top sails & courses the ship George & Susan in sight middle part fresh breezes & squally heading S.S.W.

Lat 23-37<sup>W</sup> Last part strong breezes from the E.S.E. and rugged  
Lon 93-18 heading by the wind to the southward scene

Wednesday January 24<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with moderate breezes from the E.S.E. heading by the wind to the southward under single reefed top sails & courses at 10 P.M. turned the reef out of the main top sail set main top gallant sail and fly jib. ship George & Susan in sight middle part fresh breezes & rugged heading south. Last part fresh breezes from the eastward

Lat 25-15 heading by the wind to the southward with two sails  
Lon 93-35 in sight scene
