last part fresh breezes from the southward employed in
stowing down oil and setting up casks for water coen

Thursday March 15th

Commences with fresh breezes from the southward & fine weather
employed in setting up casks for water
middle part calm and clear weather
last part light breezes from the northward with thick weather
employed in getting of water & stowing it away coen

Friday March 16th

Commences with fresh breezes from the northward
employed in getting off water & stowing it away
middle part calm and clear weather
last part light breezes from the southward & fine weather
employed in stowing down water coen

Saturday March 17th

Commences with fresh breezes from the southward
employed about various jobs of port duty
middle part calm and clear weather
last part fresh breezes from the southward
employed in stowing down water & various jobs coen

Sunday March 18th

Commences with fresh breezes from the southward
middle & last parts light breezes & fine weather
one watch ashore on Liberty coen

Monday March 19th

Commences with fresh breezes from the southward
middle part calm and cloudy weather
last part light air from the N.W. & thick weather one
watch ashore on Liberty coen

Tuesday March 20th

Commences with fresh breezes from the southward & clear
weather employed in painting the spars
middle part part calm and clear weather
last part fresh breezes from the southward employed
in painting ship one watch ashore on Liberty coen

Wednesday March 21st

Commences with fresh breezes from the southward
employed in painting ship & various jobs
middle part fresh breezes from the southward
last part moderate breezes from the southward coen

Thursday March 22nd

Commences with light breezes from the northward
one watch ashore on Liberty
middle & last parts light air from the southward coen

Friday March 23rd

Commences with fresh breezes from the southward
and fine weather the watch employed about various jobs
middle & last parts light breezes from the southward coen

Saturday March 24th

Commences with fresh breezes from the southward one watch
ashore on Liberty employed in sending sails
middle part calm and clear weather
last part light air from the southward at 5 o'clock A.M.
saw ship Robert Edwards, on fire the ship was scuttled
and sunk coen
