Commences with light breezes from the S.E. steering N. the watch employed about sunday job & ship's duty at sunset tacked to the wind on the starboard tack up West middle part light breezes heading by the wind up W.N.W. at 400 A.M. wore ship to the eastward with light air
 Lat 00-01^N Last part light breezes from the S.E. steering E.N.E.
 Lon 80-47 the land in sight off the starboard bow (over)

Thursday May 30th

Commences with light breezes from the southward & fine weather steering N. at sunset tacked to the wind up W.N.W. middle part light breezes heading from W.N.W. to N.
 Lat 00-16 Last part light breezes from the S.E. W. and fine weather
 Lon 81-34 heading up by the wind to the westward (over)

Friday May 31st

Commences with light trade winds from the S.E. W. and fine weather heading up by the wind, N. middle part light breezes & thick weather heading W.N.W. Last part moderate trade winds from the S.E. W. steering W.N.W. employed in repairing the sparber saw a sail to the leeward at noon spoke Bark *Clarice* of New Bedford
 Lat 00-32 18 ms out 400 lb sperm oil (over)
 Lon 82-30

Saturday May 12th

Commences with moderate trade winds from the S.E. W. steering E.S.E. the *Clarice* in sight to the windward at sunset tacked ship to the westward middle part moderate breezes & fine weather heading from W. to S.W. by W. the *Clarice* in sight Last part moderate breezes from the S.E. W. heading up on the starboard tack to the westward
 Lat 00-33 the Bark *Clarice* in sight astern and sail off the
 Lon 83-34 weather low (over)

Sunday May 13th 1855

Commences with moderate trade winds from the S.E. W. and fine weather heading up by the wind to the westward at sunset tacked ship to the S.E. by E. three sails in sight middle part moderate trades heading to the E.S.E. at 300 A.M. tacked ship to the westward at daylight three sails in sight Last part moderate breezes from the S.E. heading
 Lat 00-35 to the eastward saw finbacks & blackfish three sails
 Lon 83-57 in sight (over) the mate sick

Monday May 14th

Commences with moderate trade winds from the S heading up by the wind on the starboard tack E.S.E. at 400 P.M. tacked ship to the W.S.W. with three sails in sight at 700 P.M. spoke Bark *Leonidas* of New Bedford 2 ms 400 lb sperm middle part light breezes heading to the E.S.E. Last part moderate trades heading by the wind to the W.S.W. at noon tacked ship to the Eastward (over)

Tuesday May 15th

Commences with moderate trade winds from the southward heading by the wind to the eastward the *Leonidas* in sight middle part moderate breezes heading to the E.S.E.
 Lat 00-20 Last part moderate trades from the southward & fine
 Lon 84-18 weather heading by the wind to the E.S.E. (over) the mate sick

Wednesday May 16th

Commences with moderate trade winds from the southward & fine weather heading to the E.S.E. middle part moderate breezes heading to the E.S.E. at daylight tacked ship to the W.S.W. Last part moderate breezes from the southward heading up by the wind on the starboard tack to the W.S.W. at noon tacked ship to the E.S.E.
 Lat 00-38 the mate sick (over)
 Lon 85-24
