

Thursday May 17th 1855

Commences with moderate trade winds from the southward and fine weather heading up by the wind on the starboard tack to the E. S. E. middle part moderate breezes heading to the E. S. E. at daylight tacked ship to the S. W.

Lon 81° 15' W at 7⁰⁰ A.M. tacked ship to the S. E. S. E. over

Friday May 18th

Commences with moderate trade winds from the southward heading by the wind to the E. S. E. at sunset tacked ship to the W. S. W. middle part moderate trades & fine weather

Lat 05° 42' N
Lon 81° 47' W at 7⁰⁰ A.M. tacked ship to the E. S. E. over

Saturday May 19th

Commences with moderate trade winds from the southward at 1⁰⁰ P.M. kept her away E. N. E. middle part moderate breezes steering N. W.

Lat 05° 33' N
Lon 81° 17' W Last part moderate trades from the southward steering from N. E. by E. to E. over the mate sick

Sunday May 20th

Commences with moderate trade winds from the southward steering East with fine weather middle part light breezes heading to the eastward at daylight the land in sight kept her away N. E. Last part moderate breezes handy in with the land at 10⁰⁰ A.M. came to anchor in Port de la Galera in 3 fms at 11⁰⁰ got under way again & kept her away for Secamas over

Monday May 21st 1855

Commences with light breezes from the southward steering N. N. E. handy in with the land at 3⁰⁰ P.M. came to anchor at Secamas in 4 fathoms water middle part calm with a heavy swell Last part light trades all hands employed in working and various jobs occur

Tuesday May 22nd

Commences with light trades & a heavy swell employed in cutting and getting off wood middle part calm and fine weather Last part calm & fine weather employed in working over

Wednesday May 23rd

Commences with light trades & fine weather employed in working & various jobs middle part calm and fine weather Last part light breezes and thick weather employed in getting off wood and stowing it away over

Thursday May 24th

Commences with light air from the southward and thick rainy weather employed in getting off wood & various jobs middle part calm and thick weather Last part light breezes & fine weather employed about various jobs of port duty over

Friday May 25th

Commence with fresh trades from the S. W. & fine weather middle part light air and fine weather Last part calm & fine weather employed about sundry jobs of port duty over
