

Wednesday June 20th 1855

Commences with light breezes from the S. S. W. and fine weather heading to the W. S. W. at 10 A.M. commenced boiling at sunset wore ship to the eastward middle part light airs and calms employed in boiling
Lat 00-47
Lon 96-48 ship to the S. W. employed in boiling scene

Thursday June 21st

Commences with moderate breezes from the S. S. E. heading by the wind to the eastward employed in boiling at 4 P.M. finished boiling and washed off the decks at sunset tacked ship to the eastward middle part moderate breezes heading to the eastward
Lat 00-58
Lon 96-58 ship to the S. E. heading to the E. N. E. under top-sails jib & fore sail the watch employed in coopers oil scene

Friday June 22d

Commences with moderate breezes from S. S. E. heading up by the wind E. by N. the watch employed in coopers middle part moderate breezes from S. E. by E. heading N. E. by E.
Lat 00-27
Lon 96-35 ship to the S. E. by E. heading up by the wind to the N. E. by E. all hands employed in breaking out in the main hold to stow down oil scene

Saturday June 23d

Commences with fresh breezes from the S. E. by E. heading by the wind to the N. E. by E. all hands employed in stowing down oil in the main hold at sunset wore ship to the S. by W. middle part moderate breezes heading to the southward
Lat 00-03
Lon 96-40 ship to the S. E. by E. heading up by the wind on the starboard tack with under top-sails and fore sail all hands employed in breaking out and stowing down in the main & fore hold at noon finished scene

Sunday June 24th 1854

Commences with moderate breezes from the E. S. E. heading up by the wind on the starboard tack from S. by S. E. W. at 2 P.M. washed off the decks & set the main sail middle part moderate breezes at 11 A.M. wore ship to the N. E.
Lat 00-53
Lon 96-49 ship to the southward & set the light sails on end

Monday June 25th

Commences with light breezes from the E. S. E. heading to the southward at 3 P.M. tacked ship to the N. E. middle part light breezes at 8 P.M. tacked ship to the S. by E.
Lat 00-27
Lon 96-58 ship to the eastward & fine weather heading by the wind to the S. by E. scene

Tuesday June 26th

Commences with moderate breezes from the S. E. and fine weather heading by the wind to the S. S. W. at 3 P.M. tacked ship to the E. S. E. middle part moderate breezes heading to the eastward
Lat 00-17
Lon 95-30 ship to the S. E. heading by the wind to the E. N. E. the watch employed about various jobs of ship's duty saw fin backs scene

Wednesday June 27th

Commences with moderate breezes from the S. S. E. heading up by the wind on starboard tack to the eastward middle part fresh breezes heading by the wind to the eastward
Lat 00-31
Lon ship to the S. S. E. heading to the eastward at 6 P.M. saw sperm whales at 7 P.M. lowered for them at 8 P.M. the starboard boat struck one at 10 P.M. took him alongside at 11 P.M. commenced cutting, whales in sight to windward going up scene
