

Friday July 12 1855

Commences with light trade winds from the S.E. and fine weather heading by the wind to the S.W. at 8 or P.M. tacked ship to the E.N.E. at sunset tacked again to the S.W. middle part moderate breezes heading to the S.W. last part moderate trades from the S.E. heading up by the wind to the S.W. the watch employed about sundry jobs so ends

Saturday July 13 1855

Commences with moderate trade winds from the S.E. heading up by the wind on the starboard tack S.W. middle part moderate breezes heading to the S.W. last part moderate trades from the S.E. heading up by the wind on the starboard to the S.W. to S. with fine weather at noon tacked ship to the eastward so ends

Sunday July 14 1855

Commences with moderate trade winds from the S.E. heading up by the wind on the starboard tack E. by N. middle part moderate breezes heading to the eastward last part moderate breezes & fine weather at 7 or A.M. tacked ship to the S.W. at noon tacked again to the eastward saw Blackbird so ends

Monday July 15 1855

Commences with moderate trade winds from the S.E. heading up by the wind on the starboard tack E.N.E. middle part moderate breezes heading to the E.N.E. last part moderate trades at 8 or A.M. tacked ship to the S.W. with fine weather the watch employed about various jobs at noon tacked ship to the E.N.E. so ends

Tuesday July 16 1855

Commences with moderate breezes from the S.E. and fine weather heading up by the wind on the starboard tack E.N.E. middle part fresh trades from the S.E. heading E.N.E. last part fresh breezes & rugged heading up by the wind E by N. all sail on - the watch employed about sundry jobs of ship's duty so ends

Wednesday July 17 1855

Commences with fresh trade winds from the S.E. heading up by the wind on the starboard tack E. middle part fresh trades heading to the wind up E by S. last part fresh trades from the S.E. and clear weather heading by the wind to the eastward so ends

Thursday July 18 1855

Commences with fresh trade winds from the S.E. heading up by the wind on the starboard tack E. middle part fresh trades heading to the wind E by S. last part fresh trades & thick weather heading to the E.S.E. employed in repairing the fore top gallant sail so ends

Friday July 19 1855

Commences with fresh trade winds from the southward heading up by the wind on the starboard tack E by S. at 1 or P.M. bent the fore top gallant sail & set it middle part strong breezes and rugged heading E.S.E. last part strong trade winds from the southward heading up by the wind on the starboard tack E.S.E. the watch employed about sundry jobs of ship's duty so ends
