

Friday September 14th 1855

Commences with light breezes from the S.W. heading to the S.E. at 2 o'clock came to anchor at Lumber. In afternoon several laying at anchor at sunset two more came in middle part light airs and fine weather last part moderate breezes & fine weather ship Hector of New Bedford came in and anchored employed in getting off wood & waste so ends

Saturday September 15th

Commences with moderate breezes employed in part day middle part moderate breezes & fine weather last part employed in getting off waste & potatoes so ends

Sunday September 16th

Commences with moderate breezes from the westward middle and last parts light breezes & fine weather

Monday September 17th

Commences with moderate breezes from the W.S.W. middle & last parts light breezes & fine weather employed in getting off wood & towing away waste so ends

Tuesday September 18th

Commences with moderate breezes & fine weather middle part fresh breezes & cloudy weather last part moderate breezes from the northward so ends

Wednesday September 19th

Commences with moderate breezes from the westward middle part fresh breezes from the westward last part light airs from the northward so ends

Thursday September 20th 1855

Commences with light breezes from the westward middle part light breezes from the westward at daylight got under weigh & stood off to the northward last part light breezes from the W.S.W. heading to the S.W. so ends

Friday September 21st

Commences with moderate breezes & variable heading up on the starboard tack from N.W. to S.E. at sunset tacked ship to the W.W. handy in with the land middle & last parts fresh breezes employed in working the bark to windward handy in with the land so ends

Saturday September 22nd

Commences with moderate breezes from the S.W. working to windward handy in with the land middle part fresh breezes from the S.E. W. last part strong breezes from the southward working to windward handy in with the land saw Blackfish & hump. back so ends

Sunday September 23rd

Commences with strong breezes from the S.E. W. employed in working the bark to windward handy in with the land saw a steamer bound to the northward middle part moderate breezes working to windward last part light airs heading from E.S.E. to S.E. so ends

Monday September 24th

Commences with moderate breezes from the S.E. W. heading S.E. at 6 o'clock came to anchor in Pista in 10 fathoms middle part fresh breezes & clear weather last part light airs & calms employed in rearing new lanyards to the fore & main rigging & painting ship out side so ends
