

Thursday September 21st 1855

Commences with moderate trade winds all hands employed in rearing new lanyards to the lower rigging and painting ship  
middle and last parts light breezes last part employed in painting ship & about the rigging as usual

Friday September 22nd

Commences with fresh breezes & fine weather all hands employed about various jobs  
middle part fresh breezes & clear weather last part light airs employed in painting ship & various jobs one watch ashore on Liberty as usual

Saturday September 23rd

Commences with fresh breezes & clear weather the watch employed in painting & sundry jobs sent on shore & sold 21 gallons of sperm oil  
middle part moderate breezes & fine weather last part light airs & calm the watch employed in painting ship in side one watch ashore on Liberty as usual

Sunday September 24th

Commences with fresh breezes & clear weather the watch employed in painting ship  
at 5 o'clock Bark Champion of Westport came in & anchored  
middle part fresh breezes & clear weather last part light breezes the watch employed in painting ship in side one watch ashore on Liberty

Monday September 25th

Commences with fresh breezes the watch employed in painting ship & sundry jobs of port duty  
middle & last parts light airs as usual

Tuesday September 26th

Commences with fresh breezes & fine weather one watch ashore on Liberty  
middle part fresh breezes and clear weather last part light airs all hands ashore on Liberty as usual

Wednesday September 27th

Commences with fresh breezes & clear weather middle & last parts moderate breezes latter part employed in hauling off potatoes & onions as usual

Thursday September 28th

Commences with strong breezes and clear weather middle & last parts light airs & calms as usual

Friday September 29th

Commences with fresh breezes & clear weather at 3 p.m. the Brig Guise came to anchor a Peruvian Gun vessel direct from San Diego

Saturday September 30th

Had strong breezes through out the day employes getting ready for departure

Sunday September 1st

Begins with strong breezes from the South at 3 p.m. got under weigh and stood 5.12 P. out to sea steering N by E at 7 p.m. long steered by the wind middle part that 82.03 long steered by the wind the same

Monday September 2nd

Begin with a moderate breeze and fine weather steering to two men sick through the day saw several humpbacks middle part that long steering by the wind latter part fair weather steering 82.07 West to End in
