Feb 4th 1856.

Bark President at Anchor in offing
Monday Feb 4th 1856.

Commenced
fine at 11 A.M. came onboard and
took charge as Mate of the Ship

Tuesday Feb 5th "

Commenced
with strong breezes from S.E. Employed in
clearing the deck and getting ready for
sea. Sent fifty five shock heads ashore.

Wednesday Feb 6th

Commenced
with strong breezes from S.E. Employed in
receiving stores from shore and getting ready
to take the anchor also discharged 500
Plym, Dabois, Lawton, Atkins, Mannul.

Thursday Feb 7th

Commenced
with strong breezes from S.E. took onboard
baggage belonging to a Passenger Mischel
and latter fine at daylight - made the
windlass and took up Starboard anchor
and then shot on the Starboard one.
Shipped another 2000 water by the name of
George B. Hussey, the one previously
shipped having been christened Edwin P. Thompson
on other man

Friday Feb 8th

Commenced
strong took onboard 5th ship. Mischel
blowing a gale from N.E. at 5 P.M. Laid
2000 Anchor.
