 in Gaff top-sail at 4 A.M. set it again
 Lat. 45. 18 S By Obs
 Long. —

Monday Mar. 17th

Commenced
 strong from N^W during E by N under all sail
 middle the same latter thick and hazy
 weather from N^W and moderate Breezes
 Lat.
 Long.

Tuesday Mar. 18th

Commenced
 strong from N^W heading to the Eastward
 under all sail Employed in Raising Provisions
 for the Oranges etc. Saw Porpoises. Middle
 heavy squalls from N^W at 10 P.M. took in
 fore and main top. S. sails top of it Gaff top
 and sparker at 11 A.M. high Reefed fore
 and main top. sails at daylight more
 moderate made sail
 Lat. 46. 20 S By Obs
